Position Title: Dish Washer

Responsible to: Kitchen Manager

Description: The Friendship House café has helped serve our mission of feeding those in need for the past 30 years. Volunteers are essential in making sure we continue to provide healthy meals to families, friends, and neighbors of our community. The position of Dishwasher supports Friendship House by providing clean tableware to staff, residents, and community members that visit the Friendship House café.

Key Responsibilities:

- Put out plates, bowls, cups and silverware
- Wash and put away all dishes
- Wipe down all surfaces
- Take out garbage
- Sweep and mop
- Other duties as assigned

Desirable Skills:

- Attention to detail
- Ability to take direction and comply with policies and procedures
- Can lift at least 25 lbs.
- Can stand for a few hours at a time
- Ability to work well in a face paced environment
- Support Friendship House mission

Location and Time Commitment:

- Weekly commitment of one shift per week
- 3-month minimum commitment
- Training must be completed on a weekday (schedule with Volunteer Coordinator)

breakfast: **6:45am to 9:30am**, lunch: **10:45am to 1:30pm**, and dinner: **4:45pm to 7:30pm**.

Weekends*

breakfast: **7:45am to 10:30am**, lunch: **11:45am to 2:30pm**, and dinner **4:45pm to 7:30pm**.
