Position Details: The Kitchen Server will be in a fast-paced environment working closely with others. These tasks include customer service skills, attention to detail, willingness to take direction, and an embrace of diversity in the workplace.

- Prepare kitchen for incoming guests and keep count of all guests
- Put out and put away food
- Make beverage to serve
- Wipe down all counter tops, clean grill, clean backsplash, refrigerator, and freezer doors.
- Take our recycling and garbage
- Sweep and mop serving area
- Other duties as requested

Location and Time Commitment: Volunteers are asked to commit to at least one shift per week for a minimum of three months. All service will be completed at Friendship House Café at 108 Snoqualmie Street, Mount Vernon. Following are the available shifts

- Weekdays: Breakfast at 6:45-9:00, lunch at 10:45-1:00, and dinner at 4:45-7:00
- Weekends: Breakfast at 7:45-10:00, lunch at 11:45-2:00, and dinner at 4:45-7:00
- *Ending times for shifts are only estimates. Volunteers are expected to remain until all duties are complete.
