Position Overview: Landscaping or Handyperson Volunteer work includes tending to our garden beds and flowers. This also includes other outdoor tasks as work and ability allows. A Donation Sorting Volunteer is primarily a behind-the-scenes support for Friendship House. This involves organizing the storage room, keeping inventory or picking up and dropping off donations.

Position Details: This role is primarily tailored to the current needs and the skills and abilities of the volunteer. This could include gardening, painting, renovating playgrounds, installing walkways, or moving supplies between offices. Organizing storage room and keep inventory, pick up and drop off donations, and help with various projects.

Location and Time Commitment: Dates and times are largely dependent on volunteer availability and the tasks that need to be done. The location will also vary between Friendship house's sites depending on the work being done. Details of this role will be agreed upon by the volunteer and Friendship House Staff.
