That is why we have opened a laundry service called, **Love & Laundry** for people who otherwise would not have the means to wash their clothes. The position of Laundry Worker helps us maintain our laundry facilities and provides opportunity to people trying to clean-up for potential employment, health, etc.

Key Responsibilities:

- Volunteer 1pm to 4pm Tuesdays
- Treat guests with respect and compassionate care
- Supervise individuals loading machines
- Operate washer and dryer as required
- Responsible for cleanliness and maintenance of work area
